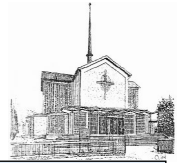

Dear Parishioners,

Holy Week is upon us and I have to admit to being barely ready. It has been a very busy time over the last few weeks. I hope all the services go well. Thank you to those who have been invited to participate.

Please check the daily schedule for details of where and when our Holy Week and Easter services will be.

Confessions will be at the usual times on Saturday and during the week on Tuesday from 9-12 noon and 5- 8pm. Thursday, Friday and Saturday 10 am – 11 am. No confessions next Saturday evening.

The Triduum Services will be held in each of our churches. Their liturgies are rich with the story of the Passion. On Palm Sunday we have 700 Palms to distribute between the Congregations at Our Lady's and St Peter's.

The Liturgy of the Easter Vigil mass is not a short Mass and is not suited to young children or those with a short attention span.

The envelopes for your Easter gift to the Clergy are available in the Church.

From Easter Sunday the water in the holy water stoops returns.

The Passion Play on Palm Sunday begins at 3pm at St Peter's and it is free. We shall have a retiring collection for the people of the Ukraine.

The office staff will be away 19th -22nd, Fr John will be away 25-30th, we are having some electrical repairs in the office at St Peter's. The parish office will be closed until May 3rd.

Try to enter into the spirit of Holy Week. Walk with Jesus along the road to Calvary and if you go by car don't forget to pray and display!
