He pointed out that: parts of the system are 60 years old; some parts are now unobtainable; some can be made to order at great cost; not having been used for over six months there are likely now to be more faults; he could see the logic of our 'sticking plaster' temporary fix (remove faulty parts, renew the welding, refit) but wasn't confident that the whole thing would work afterwards. In short, we have now begun seeking advice about new heating. The boilers are beyond repair. Our Lady's: the same engineer has been asked to look at Our Lady's boiler. This new firm has been more use to us in an afternoon than the old has been in six months... Thank you for your patience and giving!
