Church Heating: At St Peter's: an engineering firm has made a site visit and has submitted the first detailed estimate (under diocesan rules we need three). Their cost will be £86,000. At Our Lady's we are booking an electrician to change the control and timing system, once the quote has arrived. We are expecting it soon.

ARRANGING A BAPTISM

Congratulations on the birth of your baby! First of all, parents must begin the process by seeing Fr Stephen in person after a Sunday Mass. He can then check a few simple facts and give out a baptism application form. We do not deal with initial arrangements by phone, email or through other members of the family. Parents are required to attend a preparation session before the baptism can take place.

ARRANGING A WEDDING

Congratulations on your engagement! To arrange a wedding, an initial meeting with Fr Stephen is necessary so that the canonical and civil processes can be explained and correctly followed. Couples need to give at least six months' notice.
