### CANONISATION OF BLESSED CARDINAL JOHN HENRY NEWMAN, SUNDAY 13 OCTOBER 2019

**Message from Archbishop Bernard Longley:** The Canonisation of Cardinal Newman will be a day of rejoicing for the Congregation of the Oratory and for our Archdiocese. The Bishops of the Archdiocese will be in Rome for this significant and historic day. Following the Canonisation, there will be a national celebration at Westminster Cathedral as well as events at the Birmingham and Oxford Oratory Churches. The period from July to October this year, between the official announcement and the Mass in the Vatican has not allowed for the planning of a Diocesan pilgrimage. However, I look forward to seeing individuals and groups who will make their way to Rome in October.

Regarding our **Diocesan celebration** of Cardinal Newman as a Saint, we shall mark the Sunday after the Canonisation (**20th October at 4pm**) with Ecumenical Vespers at St Chad's Cathedral, to which we shall invite Christian, Inter-Religious and Civic Leaders from Birmingham and across the Archdiocese. All are welcome to attend on this occasion. It is hoped that this event will bring together the choirs of St Chad's and St Philip's Cathedrals.

A website has been set up regarding information leading up to the Canonisation which is being run by Jack Valero of Catholic Voices and in conjunction with the Oratory Houses in England and Wales: [www.newmancanonisation.com](http://www.newmancanonisation.com).

We should note that four other saints are due to be canonised with Cardinal Newman. Of particular note is **Blessed Mariam Thesia, foundress of the Sisters of the Holy Family in Thrissur, Kerala**. We congratulate all our Syro-Malabar clergy and faithful on the canonisation of their fellow Keralan.
