SPAN

SPAN was founded in 1974 by members of St Peter's parish to bring help to our sisters and brothers less fortunate than ourselves.

It is Catholic Leamington's registered charity giving witness of our commitment as a Christian community to our neighbours, near and far.

In 2021 we distributed £ 36,382 on your behalf; details on page 5.

Nowadays, our support for others is almost entirely financial. Members offer practical help to many of the local charities we support. That involvement provides regular insights into how our community can help further. At Christmas SPAN has coordinated a voucher scheme, given to the less well-off and small gifts to housebound parishioners.

In 2021, the amount we have received in donations and the amount we have spent **since SPAN was founded both passed £ 1.15 million.**

How to donate to SPAN

Collection boxes are in the entrances to St Peter's and St Joseph's. There is also a Crisis in Africa box for Darfur, Sudan at St Peter's.

Use the **SPAN envelopes** available in all three churches; these can be placed in any of our Offertory collections or the collection boxes.

Set up a **Standing Order** from your Bank or Building Society; forms available in church or at the back of this booklet.

Gift Aid envelopes are provided in church for taxpayers; this increases the value of donations by 25%. Contact our Treasurer to register and get your own Gift Aid Number to save filling in details on each envelope used.

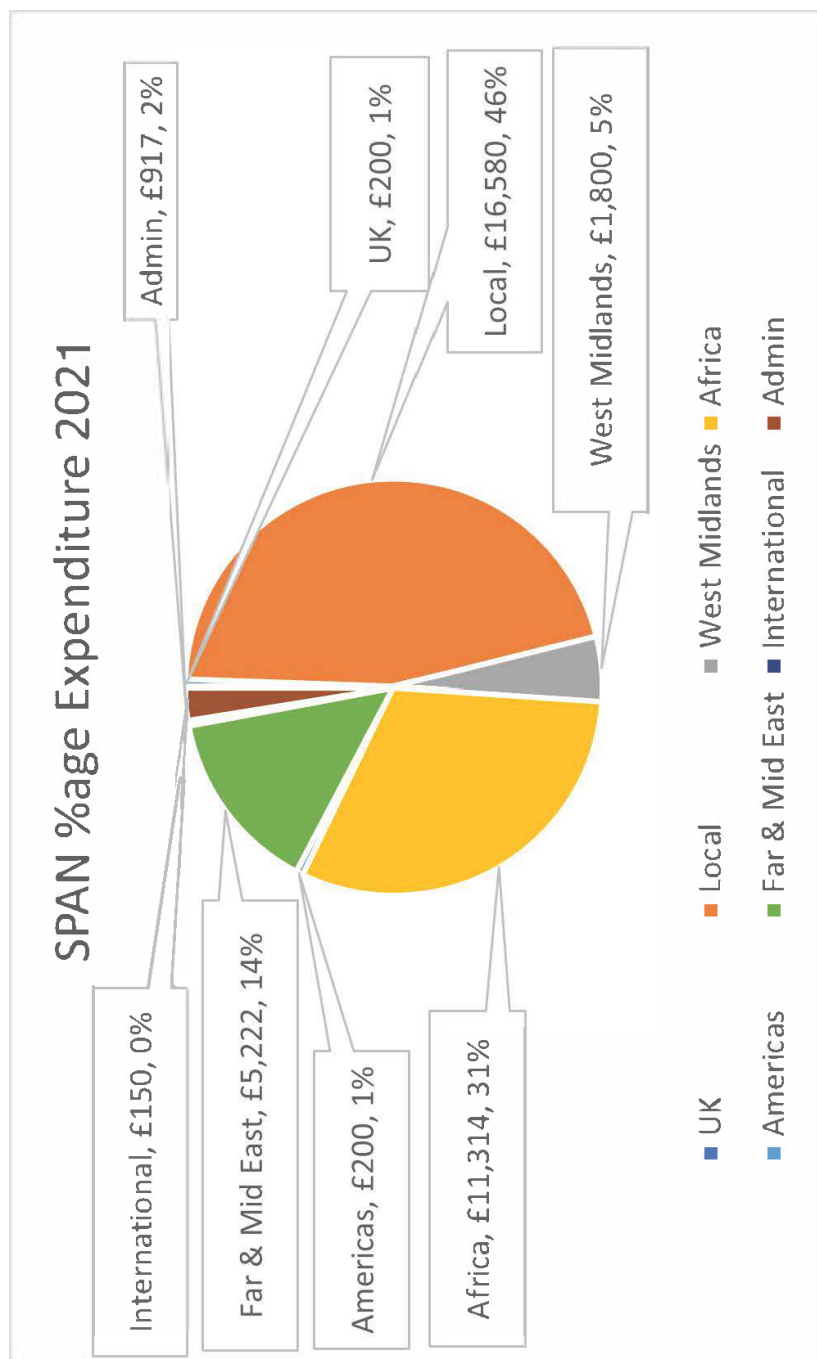

YOUR DONATIONS DO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Every month in 2021 SPAN sent money directly to these projects:

Sum	Organisation and description of work
£ 100	Warwick District Foodbank - across 7 centres. Providing 3-day emergency food supplies for our local need.
£ 100	Leamington Night Shelter - At Radford Road Church, opened on Sunday and Wednesday nights. Offering food and company from 9pm. Before lockdown, helping around 35 people with about 12 staying overnight.
£ 200	Saturday Friendship Group - The Way Ahead Project - Jointly with The Salvation Army. Providing a drop-in, advice and activities. Offering the homeless community support to get their lives back on track.
£ 50	3H - Housing, Health Hospitality - Support for the families of two formerly trafficked women at a house in Kenilworth.
£ 100	Fr David Cullen - White Father - Working in Chipata, Zambia. Helping to support the neediest. Regular emails tell us how he works with the local SVP and others.

A monthly amount is set aside to the following, money being sent after it has accumulated so that SPAN only pays periodic bank transfer fees:

Sum	Organisation and description of work
£ 83	House of Light and Hope , Beirut, Lebanon. Supporting the work of Dr Robert Caracache sheltering and educating street children and refugees.
£ 37	Fr G U Mayele , Uganda. Supporting the education of vulnerable children.

Further income each month is shared between appeals and two Mission Hospitals using a fixed % allocation:

%	Organisation	Description of organisation's work
20	St Francis Leprosy Community Hospital, Nyenga, Uganda	Owned by Catholic Diocese of Lugazi. Supporting Sr Monicah Nassiwa and their medical teams.
20	Ortum Mission Hospital, Kitale, Kenya	Purchasing medicines and equipment, helping poor patients access the hospital services.
60	Appeals submitted before our monthly SPAN open meeting	We specifically target projects helping people in real need and do not support organisations that have a large income other than CAFOD.

Once a year the Appeals fund is used also to send £300 to each of the following whom we have supported for many years for social or educational work in their parishes:

Fr Frederick Kasozi, Otumbari, Arua, Uganda
Fr Gabriel Mwanza, Chadiza, Zambia

There is a separate standing appeal and a collection box in St Peter's porch labelled "**Crisis in Africa**", for CAFOD's support of refugees in Darfur, Sudan. Whatever is donated is sent via CAFOD.

In preparation for our monthly meetings, the SPAN committee investigates the background of the groups or charities that send us appeals – often 6-10 appeals each month but it is the open meeting that determines which appeals are agreed.

All parishioners are welcome to our monthly meetings.

We also get feedback from those we have supported.

The meetings take place at 7.30 pm on the second Monday of each month (except August) in the Parish Hall at St Peter's.
