SPAN

SPAN was founded in 1974 to bring help to our sisters and brothers less fortunate than ourselves.

It is Catholic Leamington's registered charity giving witness of our commitment as a Christian community to our neighbours, near and far.

In 2025 we distributed around £ 54,000 on your behalf;
a greater sum than usual using the Frank Garvey Legacy – full details on page 5.

Nowadays, our support for others is almost entirely financial. Members offer practical help to many of the local charities we support. That involvement provides regular insights into how our community can help further. At Christmas and Easter SPAN has coordinated a food voucher scheme, given to the less well-off, as well as appealing for other local and international causes.

In 2025, the amount we have received in donations and the amount we have spent **since SPAN was founded is around £ 1.28 million.**

How to donate to SPAN

Collection boxes are in the entrances to St Peter's and St Joseph's Churches. There is also a Crisis in Africa box for Darfur in Sudan at St Peter's.

Use the **SPAN envelopes** available in all three churches; these can be placed in any of our offertory collections or the collection boxes.

Set up a **Standing Order** from your Bank or Building Society; forms available in church or at the back of this booklet.

Gift Aid envelopes are provided in church for taxpayers; this increases the value of donations by 25%. Contact our Treasurer to register and get your own Gift Aid Number to save filling in details on each envelope used.

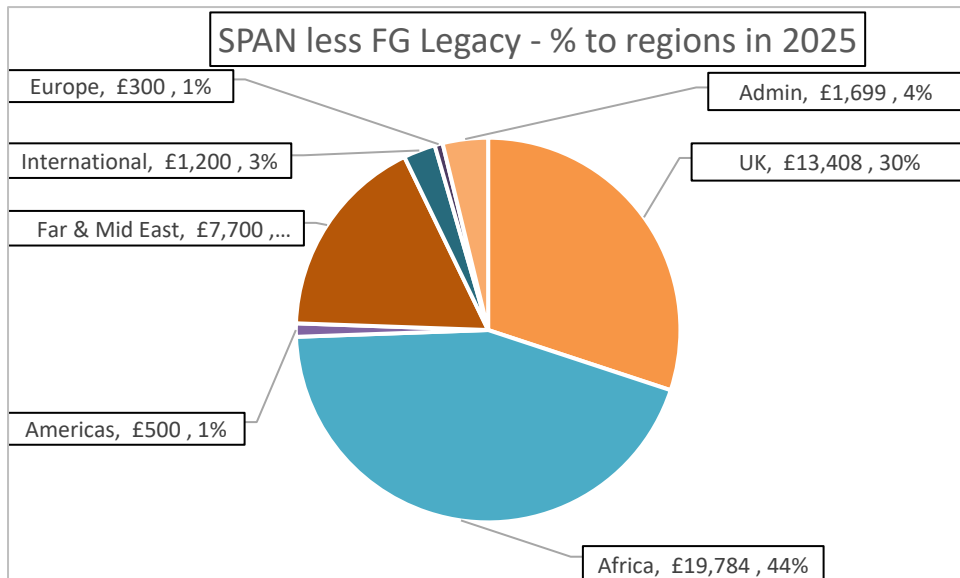
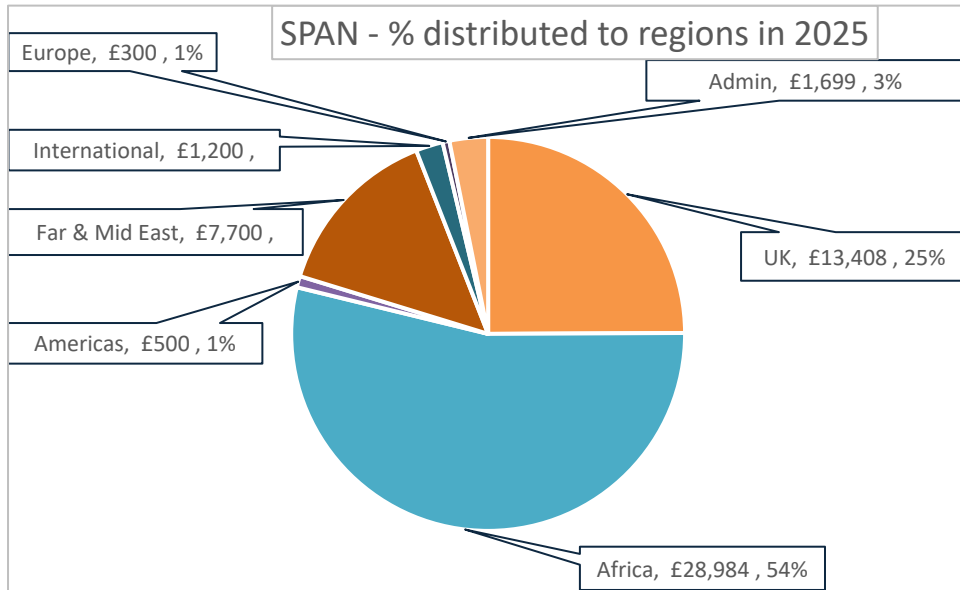

Every **month** SPAN sends money directly to core projects:

Sum	Organisation and description of work
£ 100	Warwick District Foodbank - across 7 centres. Providing 3-day emergency food supplies for our local needy.
£ 83	House of Light and Hope , Beirut, Lebanon. Supporting the work of Dr Robert Caracache sheltering and educating street children.
£ 37	Fr G U Mayele , Uganda. Supporting the education of vulnerable children.
£ 100	New Chapters - Providing an affordable drug and alcohol recovery programme in the Leamington area
£ 100	Hope House Babies Home in Nairobi, Kenya – where abandoned babies are given a healthy start.
£ 100	Young People First in Leamington – providing a variety of counselling, development and nutritional support .

There is a separate standing appeal and a collection box in St Peter's porch labelled "**Crisis in Africa**", for CAFOD's support of refugees in Darfur, Sudan. Whatever is donated is sent via CAFOD

Further income each month is shared between appeals and two Mission Hospitals using a fixed % allocation:

20	St Francis Leprosy Community Hospital, Nyenga, Uganda	Owned by Catholic Diocese of Lugazi. Supporting the Sisters and their medical teams.
20	Ortum Mission Hospital, Kitale, Kenya	Purchasing medicines and equipment, helping poor patients access the hospital services.
60	Appeals submitted before our monthly SPAN open meeting	We specifically target projects helping people in real need and do not Sr Susan Namliika support organisations that have a large income other than CAFOD.

Once a year the Appeals Fund is used also to send £400 to each of the following whom we have supported for many years, for social or educational work in their parishes:

Fr Frederick Kasozi , Otumbari, Arua, Uganda
Fr Gabriel Mwanza , Chadiza, Zambia

All parishioners in Catholic Leamington are welcome to our monthly meetings.

- We receive feedback from those we have supported.
- The SPAN committee research the groups or charities that send us appeals – often 6-10 appeals each month.
- The Open Meeting determines which appeals are agreed.

Meetings take place at 7.30 pm on the second Monday of each month (except August) in the Davenport Room at St Peter's.
