Expected Behaviour Policy

To enable a safe and nurturing environment for everyone attending our youth clubs it is important that we have expectations of acceptable behaviour. Whilst we aim to provide inclusive provision, anyone not adhering to our behaviour policy will not be able to attend the club.

- All members will have signed consent forms.
- Whilst we welcome all young people, the club is founded on the teachings of the Catholic Church and as such will include faith based activities and prayer. All members will be expected to engage with these activities.
- Members will show respect for others at all times. This includes towards volunteer leaders as well as to other young people in the group.
- Young people must respect the property of the Church and their peers. There will be no purposeful damage to either.
- For the safety and enjoyment of all members, disruptive, violent or rude behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Whilst 'being in high spirits' is expected when having fun with friends. Each young person will agree to listen to instructions and behave accordingly. Any special needs with regards to medical or behavioural issues that might impede this should be brought to the attention of the person in charge so that provision can be made for inclusion.
- There will be no use of, or intoxication from, drugs or alcohol whilst participating in youth clubs or events. This includes smoking/vaping.
- All members will be expected to show respect to those of the opposite gender. As such no derogatory comments are acceptable. The privacy of all members is important i.e. no girls in the boys toilets and vice versa. Any topics such as Theology of the Body will be conducted in same sex groups (only applicable to those in years 9 plus).
- With regards to any issue, behavioural or otherwise, the final decision and responsibility is that of the Parish Priest.

We appreciate your help in ensuring that these expectations are met.
